As an ongoing genocide is being carried out in Palestine, the German government is doubling down on its colonial alliance with the state of Israel and the racist German border regime. We see this in its unconditional support of the genocidal bombing of Gaza and in its heavy police repression of protests in solidarity with Palestine here in Germany. Politicians are calling for the deportation of people committed to a free Palestine and Chancellor Scholz is vowing to start "deporting on a grand scale." While the government is developing a law to harshen the deportation system, the so-called "Repatriation Improvement Act," Palestinians and other Arab people on the streets are being labeled anti-semitic, repressed and criminalized for calling out genocide and expressing solidarity with Palestine.

We see these developments as connected, and we reject the state's instrumentalization of the Palestinian movement to increase deportations and to advance racist migration policies! We stand against borders, apartheid, and colonialism — in Palestine-Israel, Germany and everywhere! We reject the attempt to cast anti-semitism as a problem imported by Palestinians and Arab "Others" and we denounce the use of this narrative to justify anti-Arab racism, deportations and the fortifying of the border regime. Anti-semitism is a societal problem that cannot be countered with racist generalizations, isolationism or deportations!
